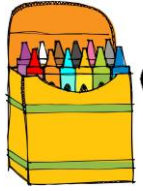

Math Quick Quizzes and Extra Practice

Over the course of the next 13 weeks, all 3rd graders will be taking weekly quizzes based on math readiness standards. These are concepts that students must master (70% or higher) in order to be promoted to 4th grade. We will be tracking the grades and concepts missed to see which students are passing these standards and to show what concepts/skills need to be retaught and practiced more.

I will begin sending home additional math practice this week. It's one page of 5-8 problems a day that review skills already taught to students to keep it fresh in their minds. This is NOT a requirement but it is encouraged since these will be skills students must know to be promoted. Work can be turned in on Fridays to be checked.
