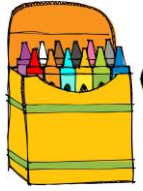

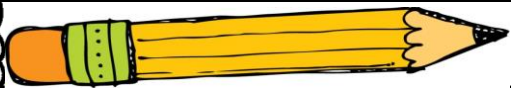
Please check your child's binder for a very important letter. This letter is due back on or before Friday, 5/5. Please make sure your child's name is on the front of the envelope!
