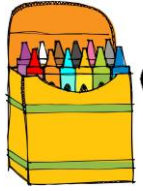

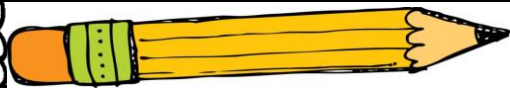
Notes from Your Teacher
