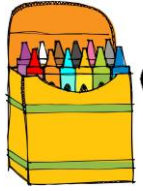

Homework

No formal homework or spelling tests will be given this year. Any classwork that is not finished will be sent home to be completed and must be returned the following day. Classwork that has a 69% or below grade can be corrected and returned for a 70. Students should read for 20 minutes nightly and practice their math facts. Your child should record it in their reading log and you initial it.

1st nine weeks reading level assessments will begin this week. Notes will be sent home with your child after they have been assessed to inform you of their current reading level. Keep in mind that your child should be reading on a level M or higher to be on-level this nine weeks.
