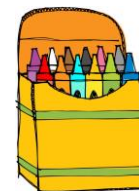

## What We're Learning this Month

**Reading-** Contemporary Literature and Drama

**Language Arts-** Revising & Editing, writing expository prompts

**Math-** Fractions (equivalent, comparing, adding/subtracting with like denominators, simplest form)

**Homework-** Math & Reading daily page, read for 20 minutes, practice basic multiplication facts

## Reminders

3<sup>rd</sup> nine weeks reading level assessments will begin at the end of the month. Keep in mind that your child should be reading on a level R or higher to be considered "on level".
